DECLARATION OF INTENT:

Pastor:

Groom: I will.

RESPONSE OF THE FAMILIES AND THE PEOPLE:

Pastor to people:

The marriage of *(Bride)* and *(Groom)* unites their families and creates a new one. They ask for your blessing. Do you who represent their families rejoice in their union and pray God's blessing upon them?

People: We do.

Pastor to people: Will all of you, by God's grace, do everything in your power to uphold and care for these two persons in their marriage?

People: **We will.**
